## *Jung and the Soul's Wound*

C. G. Jung has been labeled a mystic, a gnostic heretic, and even a new-age prophet. He was a very practical physician who saw a terrible human wound, and then dedicated himself to its care and healing. Dr. Owens will speak about his own journey with C. G. Jung as a physician, and consider Jung's engagement with the illness of our age. He will look at the clinical history of Jung's own confrontation with the soul, and his transformative journey into the imaginative and mythopoetic matrix underlying consciousness, documented in his famous *Red Book - Liber Novus*. Over fifty years after his death, does Dr. Jung still have a prescription to offer our age?
